Energy Division Staff Presentation on AB 327 (10 minutes)

Questions to Parties and Discussion (50 minutes) Parties will be asked to address the following questions related to Phase I of the proceeding. We remind parties that the record in Phase I is closed:

- 1. How would higher or lower differentials between tiers affect low-income ratepayers?
- 2. AB 327 allows the Commission to adopt a fixed charge of up to \$10. Some parties propose a minimum charge while others propose a minimum bill. Discuss how these proposals will affect low-income customers.
- 3. AB 327 allows the Commission to adopt default Time of Use rates starting in 2018. What could opt-in Time of Use pilots study to better inform the Commission of the effects of default Time of Use rates on low-income customers?
- 4. What is the best method for bringing the effective CARE discount to within the 30-35% range required by AB 327?

Parties may be asked the following question about a possible future phase of the proceeding:

5. The Commission may consider re-structuring the CARE discount in a future phase. What issues or facts should the Commission explore related to this issue?
