RICHARD HEATH & ASSOCIATES INC.'S ("RHA") PETITION FOR MODIFICATION OF DECISION 06-12-038 ADOPTING UTILITY BUDGETS FOR LOW INCOME ENGERGY EFFICIENCY PROGRAMS AND CALIFORNIA ALTERNATE RATE FOR ENERGY (RULES OF PRACTICE & PROCEDURE, RULE 16.4)

TO: THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION, ALJ KIM MALCOLM AND ALL PARTIES OF RECORD

RICHARD HEATH & ASSOCIATES, INC. submits the following petition for modification of Decision 06-12-038, "Order Adopting Utility Budgets for Low Income Energy Efficiency Programs and California Alternate Rates for Energy" ("Order") effective December 14, 2006. RHA is also requesting that the CPUC give this Petition expedited treatment.

SUMMARY

RHA currently is the program administrator on PG&E's and SDG&E's Low Income Energy Efficiency ("LIEE") programs.

In this proceeding, the CPUC ordered, inter alia,

- PG&E to present a plan to the Energy Division to conduct a competitive bid process for
 its LIEE administrator for hiring the LIEE administrator for 2008 (see ordering paragraph
 14; emphasis added); and further ordered
- SDG&E to present a plan to the Energy Division to conduct a competitive bid process for its LIEE administrator commencing December 1, 2007 (see ordering paragraph 18).

RHA submits that the Order should be modified to permit PG&E and SDG&E to extend their current LIEE administration contracts with RHA through program year 2008 with a competitively bid three year contract to be conducted for program years 2009-2011.

This modification is warranted because on March 28, 2007, in CPUC rulemaking proceedings 07-01-042, Commission Dian M. Grueneich issued a Scoping Ruling for the "Commission's Rulemaking on the Low Income Energy Efficiency Programs of California's Energy Utilities" ("Scoping Ruling"). (RHA requests that the CPUC take judicial notice of that Scoping Ruling.) In the Scoping Ruling, the Commission is undertaking a comprehensive review of the LIEE programs.

Morever, in the Scoping Ruling, Commissioner Grueneich specifically identified as an issue to be addressed in the "coming year" the "Processes for Considering Program

Improvements between Utility Budget Cycles" stating "Our intent is to move to a three-year program funding cycle beginning in 2009." (Scoping Ruling at p. 2; emphasis added.)

Given the CPUC's stated intent to move to a three year funding cycle, it makes little sense for the reasons stated below to potentially disrupt services to LIEE program participants by bidding out the PG&E and SDG&E program administration functions for the 2008 program year and then re-bidding in 2008 for the three year budget cycle in 2009-2011.

II.

BIDDING OUT THE LIEE PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION CONTRACTS FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2008 AND AGAIN IN 2009 IS INCONSISTENT WITH THE CPUC'S STATED INTENT AND WOULD SERIOUSLY DISRUPT LIEE PROGRAM SERVICES.

There are numerous reasons to modify the Order and to defer bidding out the PG&E and SDG&E LIEE program administration contracts until program year 2009.

- First, as set forth in the Scoping Order, it is clear that the CPUC's intent is to move to a three-year program funding cycle beginning in 2009.
- Second, the original rationale for the Order requiring the bidding out of the administration contracts for SDG&E and PG&E was the "concern" whether administration costs were "high." (Order at pp. 35 and 41.) However, if the entire LIEE program design may change as potentially contemplated in the Scoping Order, then a bid for only one year will not adequately address the CPUC's concerns regarding administration costs. The reason is that the 2008 programs administration functions (and the attendant administration cost) may differ significantly from the program administration functions in 2009. What then will there be to compare and to what end?

- Third, as a practical matter, bidding out the LIEE program administrator functions in both 2008 and 2009 will unnecessarily create the very real potential for disruption of services to LIEE program participants. The Commission should be aware that based on RHA's long-time experience as program administrator of various CPUC programs, it can take at least four months to ramp up and develop the infrastructure to begin delivering LIEE services at required production levels to meet annual program goals. If a new program administrator is selected for 2008 and 2009, there would be a two month period during this ramp-up phase where it is likely that no services would be provided to LIEE program participants which is inconsistent with Commission goals. The LIEE programs in PG&E's and SDG &E's service territory could possibly come to a halt in 2008 and 2009 (if there were new administrators) and the following negative effects would certainly occur:
 - 1. Fewer low income customers receiving services;
 - 2. Delays in outreach;
 - 3. Unit goals not being met;
 - 4. Therm and kilowatt savings not realized; and
 - 5. Subcontractor lay offs and loss of trained personnel as any down time will undoubtedly result in employees looking for new work.
- Fourth, further delays in implementing PG&E's Energy Partners Program may occur because PG&E has historically bid out the administration contract only. The selected program administrator is then charged with finding qualified subcontractors and evaluating their bid responses for 58 project areas. PG&E must then approve the subcontracts including the prices therein. This subcontractor selection process can take

approximately two months. During that period, the provision of LIEE services stops because the subcontractors have not been selected and approved. In short, why cause the cessation of the LIEE program services in two consecutive bid years; i.e. 2008 and 2009 for no good reason.

Finally, bidding out the LIEE programs for two consecutive years will waste valuable resources. In order to respond to a bid, whether it is for the LIEE administrator or a subcontractor submitting bids to the program administrator, each bidder must expend considerable time and resources. While RHA believes that competitive bidding is a laudable goal, having a competitive bid program will divert valuable resources from providers including Community Based Organizations ("CBOs") facing the daunting prospect of responding to bids for two consecutive years. Subcontractors, including the CBOs, do not have the large administrative capacity to respond to bids, let alone in consecutive years.

III.

SUBCONTRACTORS CONSISTING OF COMMUNITY BASED ORGANIZATIONS AND SUBCONTRACTORS JOIN IN RHA'S PETITION.

Attached hereto as Exhibit A is a joinder in RHA's Petition for Modification which RHA's subcontractors have signed in counterparts. These subcontractors are currently providing services under PG&E's and SDG&E's LIEE programs and join in RHA's Petition.

THE COMMISSION SHOULD MAKE THE FOLLOWING SUGGESTED MODIFICATIONS TO THE ORDER.

- Paragraph 14 of the Order should provide:
 - "PG&E shall conduct a competitive bidding process for its LIEE administrator for hiring the LIEE administrator for program years 2009 through 2011. PG&E shall extend its existing contract with Richard Heath & Associates, Inc. through December 31, 2008."
- Paragraph 18 of the Order should provide:
 "SDG&E shall conduct a competitive bidding process for its LIEE administrator for programs years 2009-2011. SDG&E shall extend its existing contract with Richard Heath & Associates, Inc. through December 31, 2008."

V.

<u>PG&E AND SDG&E IN THEIR PETITION FOR</u> MODIFICATION.

Richard Heath and Associates, Inc. strongly supports PG&E and SDG&E in their Petition for Modification of the Order. RHA supports the goals of serving more customers and maintaining continuity and progress towards the overall goal of energy savings.

VI.

CONCLUSION; EXPEDITED TREATMENT.

RHA submits that good cause exists to modify the Order and requests that its Petition be granted. Further, RHA requests that the CPUC grant expedited treatment of this Petition because

the bid preparation process is moving forward. Should the CPUC grant RHA's Petition, numerous prospective bidders as well as PG&E and SDG&E will be able to save time and valuable resources.
