# ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE ANNUAL ESTIMATE OF CARE ELIGIBLE CUSTOMERS AND RELATED INFORMATION

On October 1, 2010, the four major investor-owned utilities (IOUs), Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, San Diego Gas and Electric Company, and Southern California Gas Company (collectively, IOUs or the Joint Utilities) jointly filed a request for an extension of time to file the annual estimate of California Alternate Rates for Energy eligible customers and related information (Joint Motion). The IOUs present that the requested extension until December 31, 2010 is necessary to gather accurate data to prepare for this filing and there will be no significant adverse effects of this extension.

No party since has filed an objection or opposition to the Joint Motion.

# IT IS RULED that:

1. The Joint Motion seeking an extension of time to file the annual estimate of California Alternate Rates for Energy eligible customers and related information is granted; and

2. The investor-owned utilities shall file the annual estimate of California Alternate Rates for Energy eligible customers and related information by no later than December 31, 2010.
