

## Appendix A

### Inspection Criteria Source: SCE Low-Income Energy Efficiency Manual

#### ***Installation & Inspection Criteria***

This section:

- ***Defines*** the types of inspection results
- ***Defines*** installation criteria and inspectors' responsibilities, and
- ***Explains*** how to fill out your reports.

#### ***Types of Inspection Results***

There are four (4) categories of inspection results:

- **Pass**
- **Conditional Pass** (minor repairs required)
- **Fail**
- **Hazardous Fail**

#### ***Definitions***

"**Pass**" means that the contractor met **all** installation criteria on the job.

"**Conditional Pass**" means that you found a very limited number of minor problems. The contractor is required to correct the problem(s), but no second inspection will be required.

"**Fail**" means that the contractor failed to meet one or more of the installation criteria. The contractor is required to repair the problems and a repeat inspection will be scheduled.

"**Hazardous Fail**" means that you found problems that pose **an immediate danger to life, health, or property**. Call the Program Manager immediately and follow his or her instructions.

#### ***Installation Criteria***

Requirements for an evaporative cooler installation are given in **Section 2105** of the SCE Low-Income Energy Efficiency Manual.

Requirements for a weatherization installation are given in the Southern California Gas Company's Direct Assistance program Installation Standards Manual.

Requirements for installation of indoor compact fluorescent bulbs and outdoor bulbs or fixtures are listed in **Sections 2206, 2503, and 2504** of the SCE Low-Income Energy Efficiency Manual.

Requirements for refrigerator installation standards are not yet complete but will be available before the official RFP is issued.

**Note:** *Some — not all — types of hazardous conditions are also listed in **Section 413** of the SCE Low-Income Energy Efficiency Manual.*

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### ***Your Responsibilities***

You are responsible not only for ensuring that all installation criteria have been met, but also for:

- Verifying that devices such as coolers, refrigerators or compact fluorescent bulbs were actually installed,
- Testing installed devices to be sure they are still working, and
- Verifying contract compliance (making sure that all requirements in the Edison contract, Purchase Order, and this manual have been met).

### ***When You Complete the Inspection***

The following applies to all inspections:

**DO NOT AGREE OR DISAGREE WITH CUSTOMERS ABOUT ANY COMPLAINTS THEY MAY HAVE.**

**DO NOT GET INTO A DISCUSSION OR AN ARGUMENT.**

**DO NOT MAKE ANY PROMISES ABOUT REPAIRS TO THE CUSTOMER.**

You **may** say, "I'll write that down on my report, and I'll make sure the Program Manager sees it."

Then write down all customer comments on the appropriate form (see following pages).

In addition, follow these steps:

1. When you give a Conditional Pass or a Fail to a job, note the specific problems requiring correction on the form.
2. Sign and date the form.
3. An adult member of the customer's household (age 18 or over) must be present. Print the person's full name and give the form to him or her to sign.
4. If the person signing is not the customer whose name is on the Checklist or Request form, indicate the relationship to the customer (for example,

"wife" or "brother"). If the person signing is a building manager, indicate "Manager" and a daytime telephone number.

### ***Filling Out the Evaporative Cooler Installation Checklist***

See the sample on the preceding page.

The contractor's signature, the customer's signature, and the date of installation must be on the form. If they are not, return the form to your Supervisor instead of going to the customer's home.

### ***Cooler Installation Checklist — "Contractor" Column***

The contractor should have partly filled out the form by answering each question in the column headed "CONTRACTOR". The boxes for "Yes" or "No" in that column should all have check marks.

- The first question is, "Did the customer have a 'working' window/wall or central air conditioner?"

This question requires a "Yes" checkmark. It also asks the contractor to have the customer initial the page **only if** he or she decided to remove the existing air conditioner.

- The second question is, "Was the customer involved in selecting the location of the cooler?"

This question requires a "Yes" checkmark **and** the customer's initial.

- The 3rd and 4th questions only apply if the cooler is installed through a window. The 5th question only applies if the cooler is installed through a wall.
- The last two questions cover the Refrigerator Survey and the Relamping and Porch Light services, and should be answered as appropriate.
- **All** other questions must be answered "Yes", or the job must fail inspection.

The contractor should have signed the form on the line for "Contractor Signature". The customer's name should be printed on the line "Customer Name" and the customer should have signed the line for "Customer Signature".

### ***Cooler Installation Checklist — "Inspector" Column***

You must check each item listed and confirm that the answer given by the contractor is correct. Check "Yes" or "No", as appropriate.

If the customer is not at home, **and** if you can **easily and safely** perform your inspection from outside the home, you may do so. In that case, it is okay if you do not obtain the customer's initials and/or signature.

### ***You Are Responsible For Checking All Criteria***

The items listed on the Installation Checklist form are not the only possible reasons why an Evaporative Cooler installation might fail inspection.

See also **Section 2105** for a complete list of installation criteria.

It is your responsibility to be sure that **all** installation criteria, not just the ones listed on the form, have been met.

### ***Inspection Results***

At the bottom of the Installation Checklist is a space for the result of your inspection. A Pass requires only a "P", your signature, the date, and the customer's signature (if he or she is present).


A Conditional Pass ("CP") or a Fail ("F") must include the reason code and your specific explanation, so that the contractor knows what must be repaired.

### ***Fails — Reason Codes***

Use the following codes for each type of reason an installation might fail. The table gives one possible example (out of many) for each code:

<b>CODE</b>	<b>EXAMPLE</b>
01 - Residence Ineligible	The home is heated by gas, not electricity
02 - Measure Ineligible	The measure installed is not included in the Program
03 - Unsafe condition	Inadequate clearance around attic furnace
04 - Work Incomplete	Unfinished caulking
05 - Poor work/defect	Caulking does not cover entire area
07 - SEER does not qualify	(Not currently in use)
08 - Unit not installed	A measure charged on the invoice was not actually installed
09 - Not residential dwelling	Customer lives in a residential hotel, not an apartment building
10 - Not replacement unit	Customer did not have an air conditioner before cooler installed
11 - Did not have pre-existing equipment	Customer did not have an air conditioner before cooler installed
12 - Not a new unit	Contractor installed a used cooler instead of the new ones approved by the Program

### ***Filling Out the Weatherization Inspection Request***

See the sample on the opposite page.

The Inspection Request lists each individual measure installed and, in most cases, a quantity (for example, the number of feet of weatherstripping). It does not list any other details, such as which rooms the weatherstripping was installed in.

Note the results of your inspection of each individual measure in the column marked "Pass/Fail".

- If the result is a Pass, no other notes are necessary.
- If the result is a Conditional Pass, a Fail, or a Hazardous Fail, you must explain it in the "Reason" column. The codes are printed at the bottom to assist you.

There is also blank space on the form if you need more room. If the customer has any comments or complaints, even if you Pass the job, write the comments in that space.

### ***Sign and Date the Form***

When you complete your inspection, sign and date the Inspection Request at the upper right. Then, have an **adult** member of the customer's household (age 18 or over) sign the form. Be sure to print the person's full name and, if applicable, his or her relationship to the customer whose name is on the Request.

If the person signing is the manager of an apartment building (or of a mobile home park) who gave you access to the customer's home:

- Write "Manager" on the Request
- Print the manager's full name and his or her daytime telephone number, and
- Have the manager sign the Request.

If you have more than one inspection for the same building for which the manager gives you access to the units, have the manager fill out one Request with the above information. He or she can then just initial the rest of the Requests.



## Appendix B

### **INFORMATION CONCERNING SUBCONTRACTORS**

Contractors may not subcontract any portion of this Program unless prior approval is obtained from an authorized SCE representative.

It is the policy of SCE to maximize the opportunity for women, minority and disabled veteran enterprises (WMDVBEs) to participate in its procurement of goods and services.

SCE uses its best efforts to increase procurement from MWDVBEs to achieve a combined annual goal of thirty percent or more by 1999. As a matter of policy, SCE does not use set asides, quotas or preferences to achieve its goals. WMDVBE status may not be taken into consideration in evaluating competitive bids or in making noncompetitive procurement awards.

SCE encourages prime contractors/subcontractors to utilize WMDVBEs as subcontractors. A contractor's or supplier's good faith efforts to subcontract with WMDVBEs is a factor that will be considered in SCE's bid evaluation process. While good faith efforts will be considered, a bidder's utilization of WMDVBE subcontractors/suppliers is not a factor that will be considered in the bid evaluation process.

Bidders shall bid in accordance with the provisions of the "Subcontracting Plan and Reporting Requirements," which by this reference, is incorporated and made a part of this request for proposal. Bidders may provide additional information demonstrating good faith efforts to subcontract with WMDVBEs.

SCE's Subcontracting Plan and Reporting Requirements are contained in Attachment "7." SCE requires its prime contractors to submit information on their respective subcontractors. The prime contractors are also responsible for reporting their expenditures with all subcontractors, including their WMDVBE subcontractors.

## Attachment 7

### **SUBCONTRACTING PLAN AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS**

- I. Bidder Subcontracting Plan Requirements
  - A. While it is not a requirement to subcontract any portion of work contained in this Proposal Request, whether or not a bidder indicates the use of subcontractors or subsuppliers in its proposal, the Bidder's proposal **MUST INCLUDE** the following:
    1. A completed "SUBCONTRACTING AND REPORTING PLAN."
  - B. When completing the "SUBCONTRACTING AND REPORTING PLAN," bidder shall assume 100% of the work will be awarded. Upon notification by EDISON of an award for less than 100% of the Proposal Request requirements, the selected bidder(s) shall submit within ten (10) days of such notification, an amended "SUBCONTRACTING AND REPORTING PLAN" reflecting the applicable reductions.
  - C. EDISON's goals are to award thirty percent (30%) of its purchases to Women and Minority Business Enterprises and one point five percent (1.5%) of its purchases to Service-Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises (collectively WMDVBEs). A Supplier's good faith efforts to subcontract with WMDVBEs is a factor that will be considered in the bid evaluation process. The "SUBCONTRACTING AND REPORTING PLAN" will be used as a factor in evaluating a bidder's good faith efforts to subcontract with WMDVBEs. Other information provided with the bidder in its proposal will also be considered.
  - D. Should those WMDVBEs identified in the bidder's proposal not be available at the commencement of work, EDISON expects the successful bidder to attempt to subcontract with WMDVBEs to the same extent as identified in its proposal.
  - E. If the bidder is currently verified as a WMDVBE and has not submitted certification to Edison, the Bidder should provide a copy of the documentation that granted such status. The documentation shall clearly show the verifying agency and expiration date.

1. Verification as a WMDVBE does not exempt bidder from Edison's consideration of its good faith efforts to subcontract with WMDVBEs.
2. It is Edison's policy that the WMDVBE status of bidders may not be taken into consideration in the evaluation of bids.

## II. Reporting Requirements

During the effective period of the purchase order, contractor shall provide, in a quarterly basis and again upon Edison's final acceptance of the work, an updated "SUBCONTRACTING AND REPORTING PLAN" reflecting the actual payments made to the subcontractors/subsuppliers. **Such reports shall be provided as requested in the purchase order.**

DEFINITIONS

- WMBE: a woman-owned or minority-owned business enterprise; under these rules, the woman and/or minorities owning such an enterprise should be either U.S. citizens or legal aliens with permanent residence status in the United States.
- WBE: Woman Business Enterprise: A business that is at least 51% owned by a woman; or, in the case of any publicly owned business, at least 51% of the stock of which is owned by one or more women, and whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more women.
- MBE: Minority Business Enterprise: A business enterprise that is at least 51% owned by a minority individual or group, or in case of any publicly owned business, at least 51% of the stock of which is owned by one or more minority groups, and whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more of those individuals. The contracting utility shall presume that minority includes, but is not limited to Black Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, Asian Pacific Americans, and other groups.
- DVBE: Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise: A business enterprise that is at least 51% owned by disabled veteran individual or group; or in case of any publicly owned business, at least 51% of the stock of which is owned by one or more disabled veterans, and whose management and daily business operations are controlled by one or more of those individuals.
- CONTROL: Exercising the power to make policy decisions.
- OPERATE: Being actively involved in the day-to-day management and not merely acting as officers or directors.
