I. INTRODUCTION

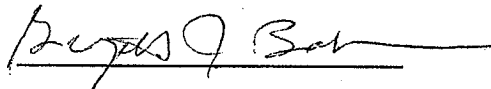
Pursuant to Decision (D.) 01-05-033, Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas), along with other investor owned utilities provides monthly and year-end reports on the costs and impacts of their Rapid Deployment efforts on their California Alternate Rates for Energy and Low Income Energy Efficiency (LIEE) programs. On February 22, 2005, among other things, SoCalGas submitted its Rapid Deployment Report for Year-End 2004.

II. ERRATA

As a result of a recent inquiry from the Energy Division and SoCalGas' independent review, SoCalGas has determined errors in its originally-filed Table 2 (LIEE Direct Purchase and Installation Contractor Expenses) and Table 5 (LIEE kWh Savings, kW Demand Reduction, Therm Savings).

The revised Table 2 and Table 5, set forth as Attachment 1, eliminate those errors. SoCalGas, therefore, requests that these revised Tables be substituted for the original Table 2 and Table 5 included in the February 22, 2005 filing.
