Low Income Potential and Goals 2023 study


Background

- Bi-annual effort to quantify energy savings potential for income-qualified sector
- Bottom-up measure-based approach (not based on individual households) developed by independent consultant, Guidehouse
- Will be incorporated into ESA WG and IOUs' mid-cycle recommendations and report

Study

- Generally, results are aligned with Decision-adopted goals

All measures and end uses (HVAC, Appliances, etc.)




All home types – Single and Multi-family, Mobile Homes




Total energy savings across all 4 IOU territories




Low Income Potential and Goals 2023 study – gas savings

ESA program design – customer segmentation



ESA program design – other considerations

- Deeper energy savings
 - \$21 million per year over 5+ years (\$104 million in total)
 - IOUs to achieve 50% energy savings per HH (compared to up to 5% historical average)
 - 2 of 3 programs underway; limited data so far

- Electrification
 - \$10 million per year over 5+ years (\$51 million in total)
 - Retrofit and New Construction pilots, and coordination with BUILD program
 - Both programs underway, limited data so far

- Cost-effectiveness
 - 0.70 Benefit-Cost ratio target for the ESA portfolio
 - 0.30 Benefit-Cost ratio target for ESA measures
 - How should the ESA programs be assessed so far?

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Concurrent Application System

CPUC adopted <u>D.23-05-006</u>

- IOUs implement Phase I of Concurrent Application System (CAS), allowing customers to concurrently apply, or begin to apply, to IOU energy programs through a single platform ESA, CARE, and FERA at a minimum
- CAS Working Group developing recommendations on Phase I design requirements
- PG&E to release RFP for CAS developer by December 29, 2023

LIOB's SB 1208 report recommendations

- Staff are reviewing and exploring LIOB's near-term recommendations
- A potential Phase II will consider other low-income energy and non-energy programs, and will be informed by LIOB's SB 1208 report and CAS Working Group

Disconnections Proceeding

Decision 23-08-049

- Extends 24-month payment plans to eligible residential customers through October 1, 2026
- Extends Arrearage Management Plan program through October 1, 2026
- Authorized the proposed Medical Baseline Study that will estimate eligible Medical Baseline population in each utility's service territory
